## South County Senior Center Board of Oversight March 17, 2022 Minutes

Pursuant to a notice duly filed with the Town Clerk, a meeting of the South County Senior Center Board of Oversight was held on March 17, 2022 at 4:03 pm. Meetings normally held at the Municipal Offices are being held remotely, with adequate, alternative means of public access and, where required, public participation provided, in accordance with the Governor's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, M.G.L. c.30A § 20.

Meeting convened at 4:03 pm with Trevor McDaniel calling the meeting to order.

Attendance: Trevor McDaniel, Tom Fydenkevez

Also present: Jennifer Remillard, Geoff Kravitz, Fran (no last name), Greg Francheschi.

Discussion: Jennifer provided background of the outreach coordinator candidate, Chris Goudreau, with focus on flexibility, mobility, customer service, and journalist background. Mention was also made on his personality being a good fit with our team. He has experience with interviewing all backgrounds and individuals within the community. He is affable, a self-starter who can meet tight deadlines, with minimal oversight.

McDaniel made motion to support the recommendation by Jennifer Remillard and Kayce Warren for the Outreach Coordinator candidate, Chris Goudreau, to the Deerfield Select Board. Tom Fydenkevez seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Item Unanticipated 48 hours prior to meeting Posting:

Discussion of the UMass Needs assessment presentation. Remillard questioned the intended audience and location of presentation. It was recommended by Fydenkevez and McDaniel she reach out to the Select Boards of each town and additional audiences to invite them to attend. Remillard proposed Whately or Sunderland as a possible location to host. She will reach out to each town to see the availability of their spaces.

Discussion of the Volunteer Appreciation event on Thursday, April 21<sup>st</sup>. Remillard wanted to make sure each BOO member received the details. She also suggested the recording of a statement or providing a statement for Remillard to read if they were unable to attend the event.

McDaniel asked for Public Comment. Greg Francheschi inquired about the location of where the SCSC would be; how long will we be at the Holy Family Parish. McDaniel let Mr. Francheschi know the duration of the SCSC presence at Holy Family and the intent to move into the Congregational Church in Deerfield.

Remillard shared there will be an outdoor space in addition to the church facility to be utilized by the SCSC staff. We are currently working in multiple locations but have the ability to be accessible to the community.

McDaniel motioned to adjourn meeting. Fydenkevez seconded. Meeting adjourned at 4:19 pm.
