Re: Transfer Station (Stickers and Regulations 2017-2018)

Once again Transfer Station “sticker season” is upon us! Last year’s regulations went well and we had some accountability at the Transfer Station that has shown up in our revenues. I will spell out the details of what the rules and regulations will be for 2017-2018.

- The Transfer Station sticker **MUST** be placed on the lower driver’s side corner of the windshield. Each sticker issued will have the vehicle registration written on it for verification purposes.
- Stickers will remain \$65. Additional vehicles registered at the same address may purchase stickers for \$10 each. Transfer Station stickers **WILL ONLY** be sold to residents of the Town of Deerfield, no exceptions will be allowed!
- Senior Discount – Town of Deerfield residents 65 years or older will receive one package of small bags at no charge, with the purchase of their initial transfer station sticker. **Seniors must be present to receive the discount.**
- Orange trash bags will continue to be used for trash. Large bags: \$25, Small bags: \$17
- After July 1, 2017, all residents will be required to have the new 2018 sticker affixed to the windshield of their vehicle. Transfer Station Attendants have been instructed to monitor this closely and non-compliant vehicles/residents **WILL NOT** be able to enter the facility.
- Transfer Station stickers can be purchased at the Deerfield Town Hall Monday thru Friday and for a limited time at the Transfer Station on Saturdays. **Please have your vehicle registration with you.**
- The facility is now equipped with two paper/cardboard compactors; all residents are urged to seek assistance from the facility attendants when utilizing these machines.
- Replacement Stickers- Remove the transfer station sticker from your vehicle before you sell or trade your vehicle. If the sticker rips in the process, bring it to the Town Hall office for a replacement.
- No replacement for lost stickers.

These rules and regulations are put in place to provide some accountability to our facility. For several years past the facility has operated in the red fiscally and was not user friendly to our residents. My job is to change those negatives into positives therefore rules, regulations and policies need to be implemented for the facility to operate successfully. Your cooperation and mindfulness will make this facility a pleasant experience for all, thank you.
