Once again Transfer Station “sticker season” is upon us! ***After July 1, 2019, all residents will be required to have the new 2020 sticker affixed to the windshield of their vehicle.***

1. Each household must purchase their own Transfer Station Sticker. “Sharing” stickers or transporting other household’s trash is not allowed. **The transfer station is for residential use only.** No stickers will be sold to/for business use (including landlords).
2. The Transfer Station sticker **MUST** be placed on the lower driver’s side corner of the windshield. Each sticker issued will have the vehicle registration written on it for verification purposes.
3. Transfer station stickers cost \$65. Additional vehicles registered at the same address/household may purchase stickers for \$10 each. Transfer Station stickers **WILL ONLY** be sold to residents of the Town of Deerfield, no exceptions will be allowed!
4. Transfer Station stickers can be purchased at the Deerfield Town Hall Monday thru Friday and for a limited time at the Transfer Station on Saturdays. (Checks only at the Transfer Station) **Please have your vehicle registration with you.**
5. Senior Discount – Town of Deerfield residents 65 years or older will receive one package of small bags at no charge, with the purchase of their initial transfer station sticker. **Seniors must be present to receive the discount.**
6. All trash must be in orange Town Trash Bags sold at the Deerfield Town Offices, the Transfer Station (checks only), Leader Lumber, and Mobile Gas Station on Conway Rd.
Large bags: \$25, Small bags: \$17
7. The facility is now equipped with two paper/cardboard compactors; all residents are urged to seek assistance from the facility attendants when utilizing these machines.
8. Replacement Stickers- Remove the transfer station sticker from your vehicle before you sell or trade your vehicle. If the sticker rips in the process, bring it to the Town Hall office for a replacement. No replacement for lost stickers.

Transfer Station Attendants have been instructed to monitor vehicles/residents closely according to these rules and regulations. Non-compliant vehicles/residents **WILL NOT** be allowed to enter the facility.

These rules, regulations, and policies need to be implemented for the facility to operate successfully. Your cooperation and mindfulness will make this facility a pleasant experience for all, thank you. Any questions, please feel free to contact me.
